



ORDNANCE CORPS HALL OF FAME NOMINATION CRITERIA



I. Eligibility (Prerequisites for Nomination)

A. Must meet all basic eligibility requirements:

- **Honorable Service:** Served honorably and received an honorable discharge or currently serving with a distinguished record.
- **Good Character:** Demonstrated consistently good character, integrity, and adherence to military values.
- **No Disqualifying Factors:** No felony convictions or other disqualifying actions
- **Connection to the Organization:** Meet specific criteria regarding service in the nominating organization, such as a specific role within the organization's history.

II. Criteria for Evaluation

A. Military Service and Contributions:

1. **Technical/Tactical Contributions:** Pioneering new strategies, contributing to military innovation or technology, or making lasting doctrinal, technical, or instructional contributions.
2. **Leadership and Command:** Service at senior level positions, significant leadership roles, demonstrated ability to inspire and lead others effectively, contributing to the success of units or missions.

B. Character and Legacy

1. **Enduring Legacy and Impact:** Making a lasting impact that transcends their individual service and benefits the military or society in the long term.
2. **Role Model/Inspiration:** Serving as a positive role model and source of inspiration to others within the military or the broader community.
