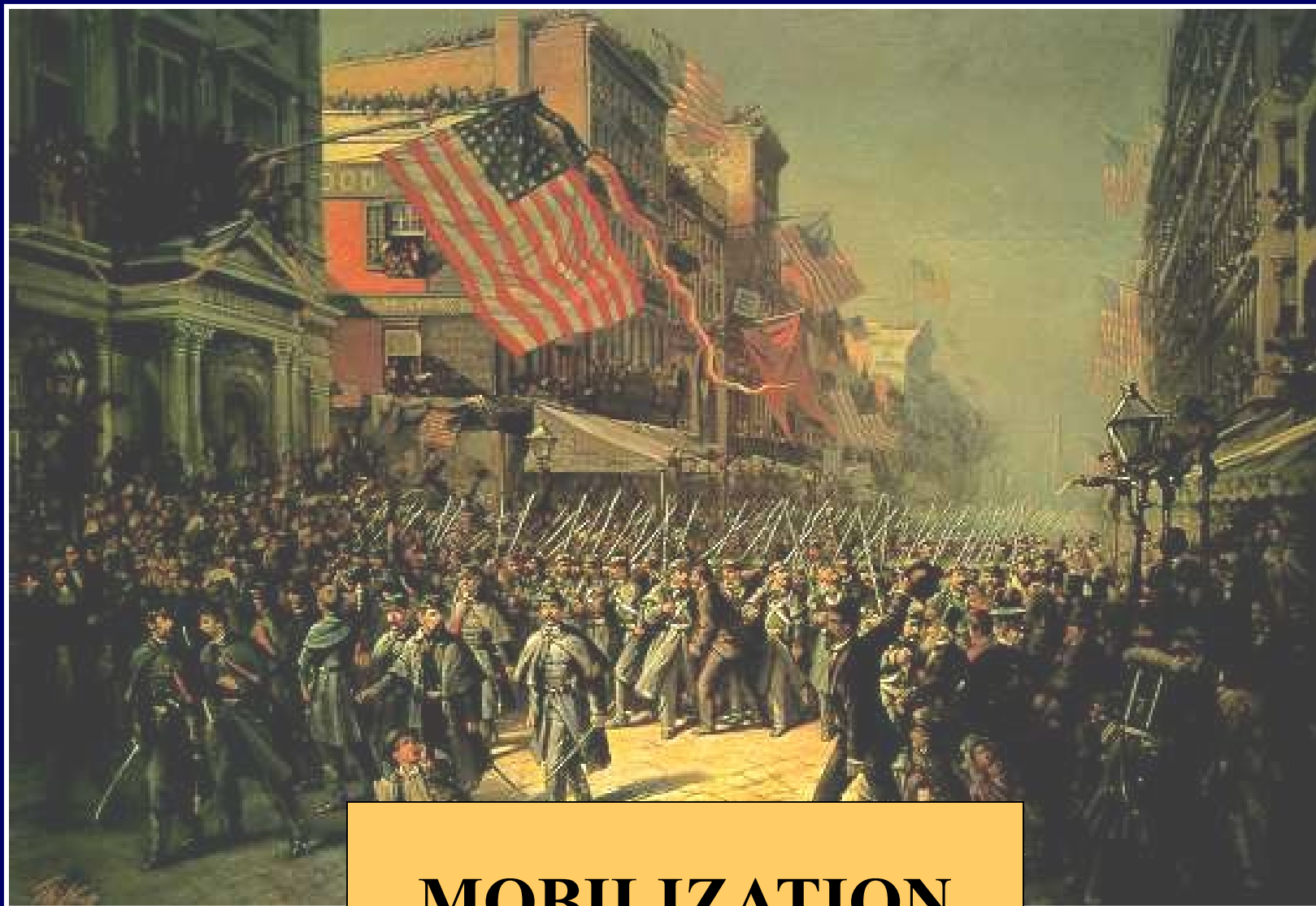

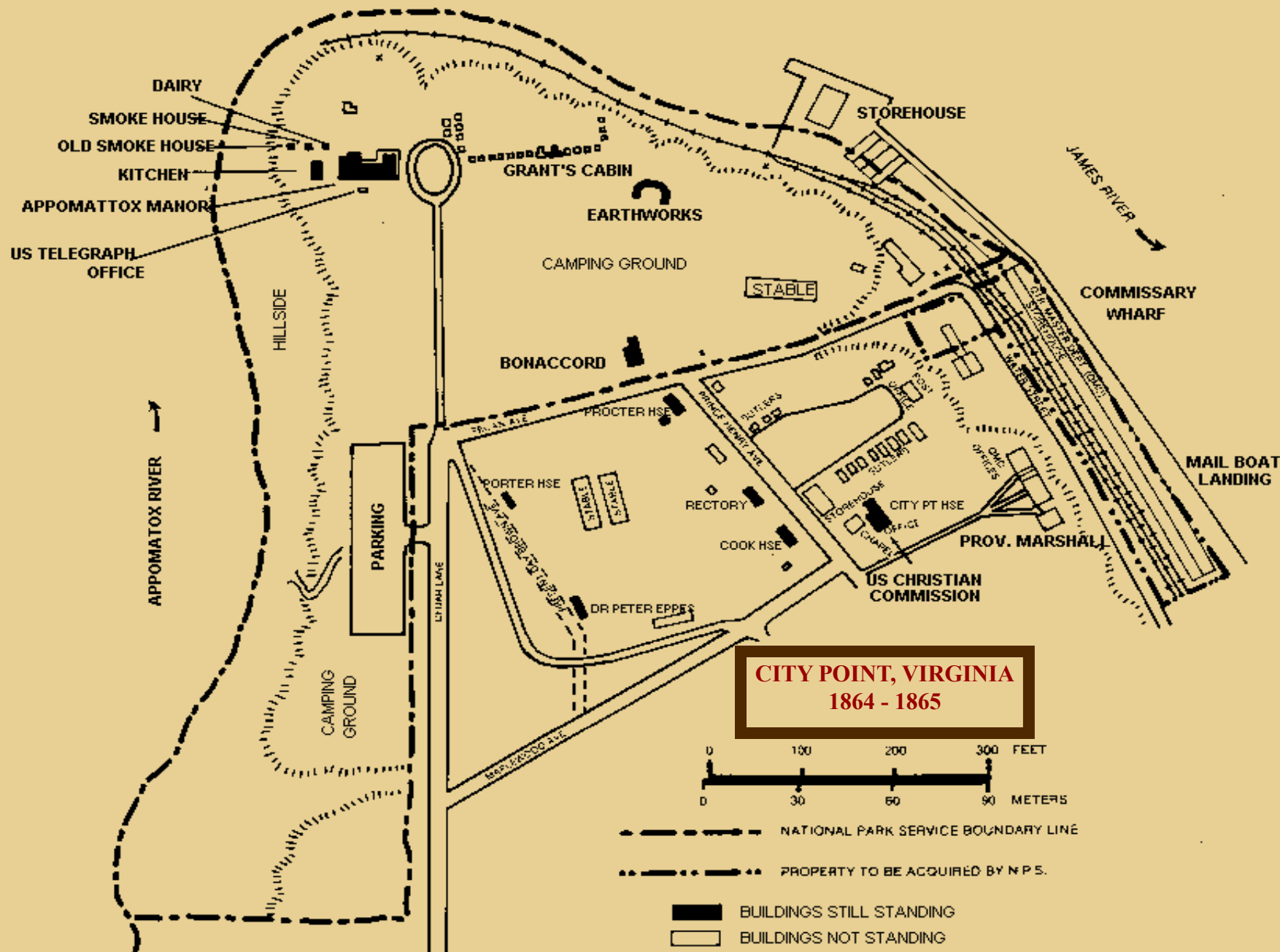
City Point Depot



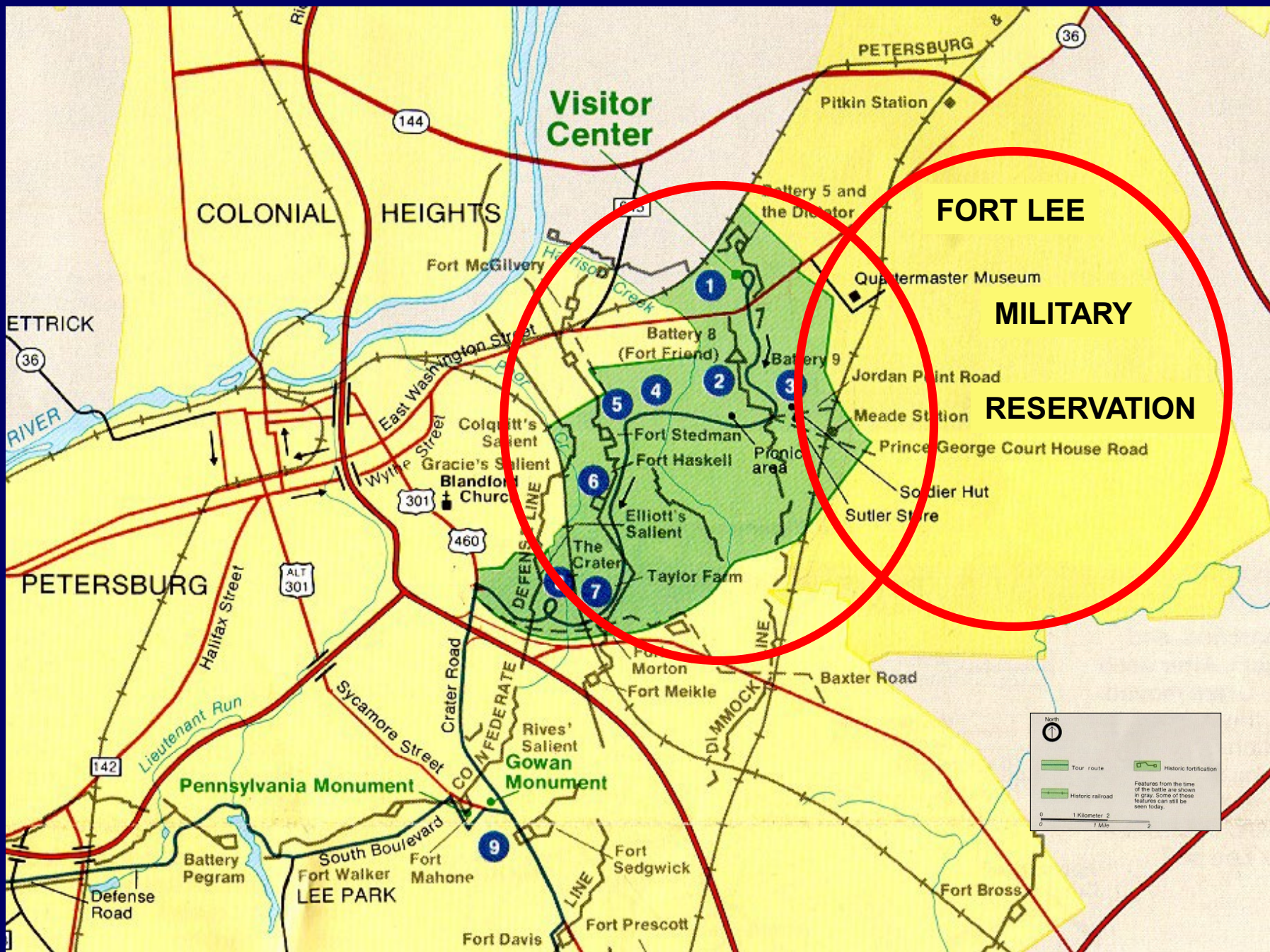
Grant's Headquarters at City Point
